




A physical therapist will show me special games and exercises to help my body get stronger.






Then we'll take the Fegan elevators to the 7th floor.

I'll go to the gym and play games to help my body get stronger.








I might sit on a bike and push with my arms and legs.

My therapist will help me and teach me new things.








My therapist will let me know when I'm all done with my appointment.
